

Examples of Possible Questions – College/Sixth Form Interviews

- 1) Why have you applied for A Levels and specifically these 3 subjects?
- 2) Why have you applied to this college?
- 3) Tell us more about your current studies (GCSEs) - especially if your GCSE subjects link to any of your A Level subject choices
- 4) Do you have a career in mind? If so why are you interested in this career?
- 5) Do you have any work experience or have you been involved in volunteering? If so what did you do and what did you gain from the experience?
- 6) What are your hobbies/interests and what have you gained by being involved in them?
- 7) Tell us about any strengths that you have, any skills, any positive personal qualities. How did you develop these strengths etc.?
- 8) Tell us about any weaknesses you have or any areas in which you want to improve?
- 9) Do you have any questions for us? (always have one or two if possible)

Write an answer for each of these questions and then carry out a mock interview with a friend (you can take turns being the interviewee and interviewer) or practice with your Careers Adviser or another member of school staff
