#### Congratulations to the Class of 2022

St Paul's Academy is delighted to announce the hugely successful outcomes in both GCSE and vocational qualifications for the Class of 2022.

Our students have shown immense dedication to their studies as well as resilience in sitting their examinations after unprecedented disruption to Teaching and Learning as a result of the pandemic. These qualities will stand them in good stead for whatever choices they make in the future and we are confident that they will continue to thrive and be successful as well as meet and overcome the challenges presented to them in the next stage to come.

The examination grades, having been externally assessed by the examination boards, have been determined solely on the basis of their publicly examined work and our students should rightly be very proud of their achievements. Our examination results have improved on our last public examinations' cohort which was in 2019. Additionally, although the Teacher Assessed Grades awarded in 2021 were based on different and more selective forms of assessment, we are delighted to announce that this year's results continue on the upward trajectory of success, demonstrating the accuracy of our professional judgement and the fairness with which last year's results were awarded.

We are very proud to report that our 2022 performance measures are as follows:

- 73% of students achieved 4+ grades in English and Mathematics
- 50% of students achieved 5+ grades in English and Mathematics
- 88% of students achieved 4+ grades in English
- 75% of students achieved 5+ grades in English
- 78% of students achieved 4+ grades in Mathematics
- 52% of students achieved 5+ grades in Mathematics
- The average Attainment 8 for all students was 48.3
- The EBacc average point score was 4.16

It is helpful to view the performance measures of the first public exams (2022) post-pandemic alongside those of 2019 the last publis exams pre-pandemic.

These performance measures clearly demonstrate our continuing journey of academic success at St Paul's.

N.B. On this occasion, GCSE RS Early Entry results were not included in Progress 8 measures.

It has been reported in the news that grades have reduced since 2021 results, but we are delighted to report that St Paul's Academy bucks this national trend with many subjects outperforming last year's results, demonstrating outstanding academic progress.

We congratulate our students who have worked so very hard in the face of adversity over the last few years. They have had to deal with lockdowns, remote learning, teachers and students being sent home with Covid, or having to self-isolate as a close Covid contact. Our students didn't have the experience of their normal school routine, as their last 'normal' school year was in Year 8. When all these things are taken into account we can begin to fully appreciate the enormity of what our students have been through to get into the examination hall to sit their public examinations, which makes their results even more outstanding. They have come so very far and we are immensely proud of them. We give thanks to the staff and to parents, carers and families for everything they have done to support the students in being successful.

The future is very bright for the Academy and we look forward to building on our success as we continue to strive for excellence for all.
