

# Apprenticeships - Levels

## What's a Level?

Apprenticeships start from an intermediate Level 2 right up to Levels 6 and 7.

- Level 2 = Intermediate Level (equivalent to four/five GCSEs at A\* to C or 9 to 4)
- Level 3 = Advanced Level (equivalent to A Levels/International Baccalaureate/BTEC Level 3/T levels)
- Level 4/5 = Higher Level (equivalent to year one/two of a Degree/HND/Foundation Degree)
- Level 6 = Degree Level (e.g. BA (Hons)/BSc (Hons))
- Level 7 = Post Graduate Level e.g. Master's Degree

Each level has different entry requirements, depending on the employer, so you can see which one is best for you.
